## OUR PROGRAMS

**Crime Prevention Councils** hold regular public meetings for the community to discuss neighborhood safety issues. SNG works directly with three Crime Prevention Councils: The **West Seattle Community Safety Partnership**, the **South Seattle Crime Prevention Council**, and the **East Precinct Crime Prevention Coalition**. SNG also participates in other crime prevention councils and works on public safety committees in other communities.

♥ We provide **No Trespassing/No Loitering signs** to participants in SPD's Criminal Trespass Enforcement program at a nominal fee. We also print brochures explaining the program and containing the sign-up forms as well as order blanks for the signs. The brochures are available in Chinese, Vietnamese and Korean. Brochures are provided at no fee to the Seattle Police Department and community organizations.

👁 SNG provides **crime prevention services to the communities of High Point, Rainier Vista, Yesler Terrace**, and several SHA High Rise buildings. We maintain offices in each community staffed by crime prevention organizers. Services include crime prevention education, referrals, block watch organizing and problem solving for on-going crime issues.

🏠 SNG continues to provide **Landlord Training workshops** in cooperation with the Seattle Police Department and the King County Sheriff's Office for **property owners/managers** of residential rental properties. This training and networking is designed to help managers avoid or remove illegal activities from their property while building

community spirit and cooperation in Southeast, West, and Central Seattle.

SNG coordinates the work in **Seattle Weed & Seed** sites. Weed & Seed is a multi-agency approach to combating violent crimes, drug trafficking and gang activity in the Southeast, Southwest and Central Area communities. The program's objectives are to "**weed**" out crime from the community and then "**seed**" in a wide range of crime and drug prevention projects and human service agency resources to promote social and economic revitalization and to prevent crime from recurring.

SNG provides **Nuisance Property** workshops for residents navigating small claims court to eliminate civil nuisance in neighborhoods.

SNG has a **Drug Free Communities** grant to support community safety and drug prevention among youth and young adults in White Center and S. Delridge.

SNG performs **Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED)** surveys on new, existing and planned structures in Seattle.

📰 We produce a bi-weekly **legislative bulletin** during Washington's Legislative session and will mail or e-mail the bulletin at no charge to any Seattle resident or organization.

SNG hosts an annual **Community Appreciation Celebration** in September to recognize the invaluable work of volunteers in the community.
